

Oregon 200 Trail Work Requirement

All racers must complete at least eight (8) hours of trail work to run the race. Trail work can be performed anytime between October 1 and July 31. You can complete the work at one work party or break it up into multiple events. Use this form for each work occurrence.

Trail work is defined as building a new or maintaining an existing trail. It does not include trash pick up. The work has to be part of an organized work party, hosted by a third-party organization.
